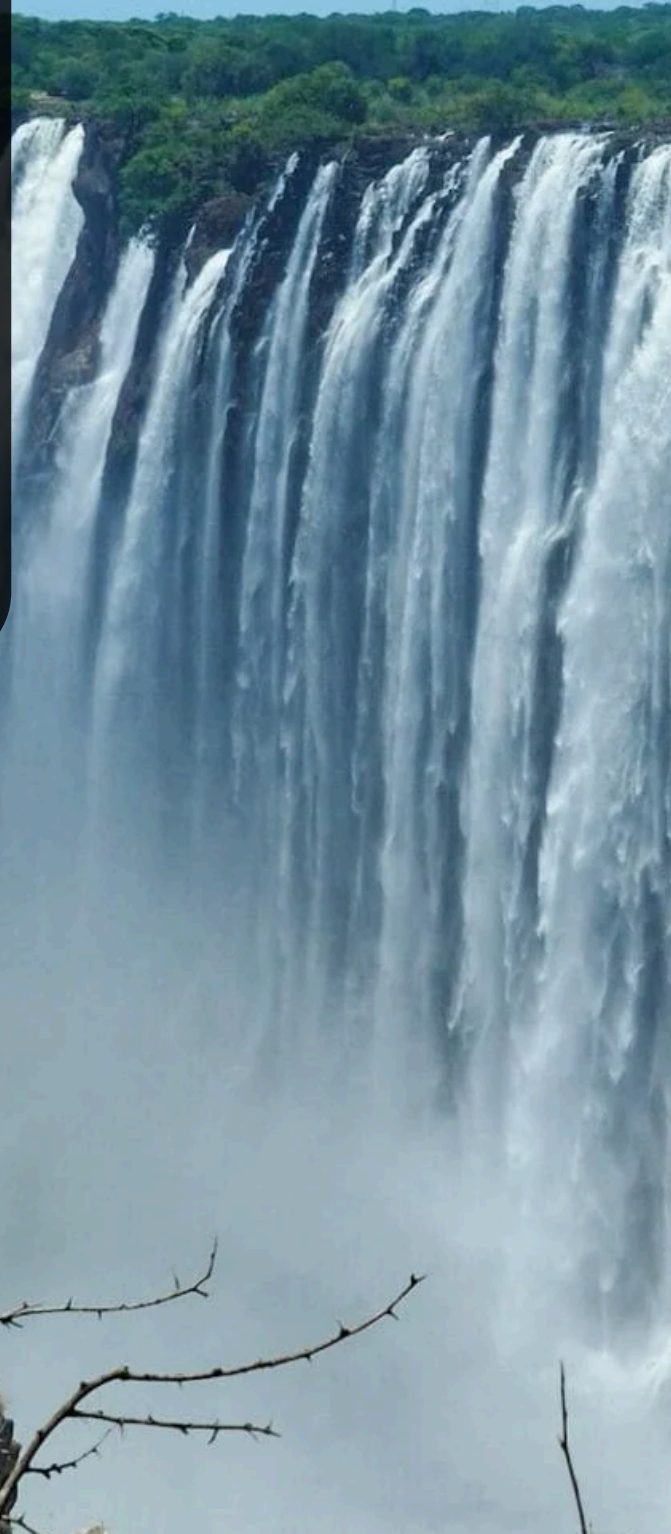

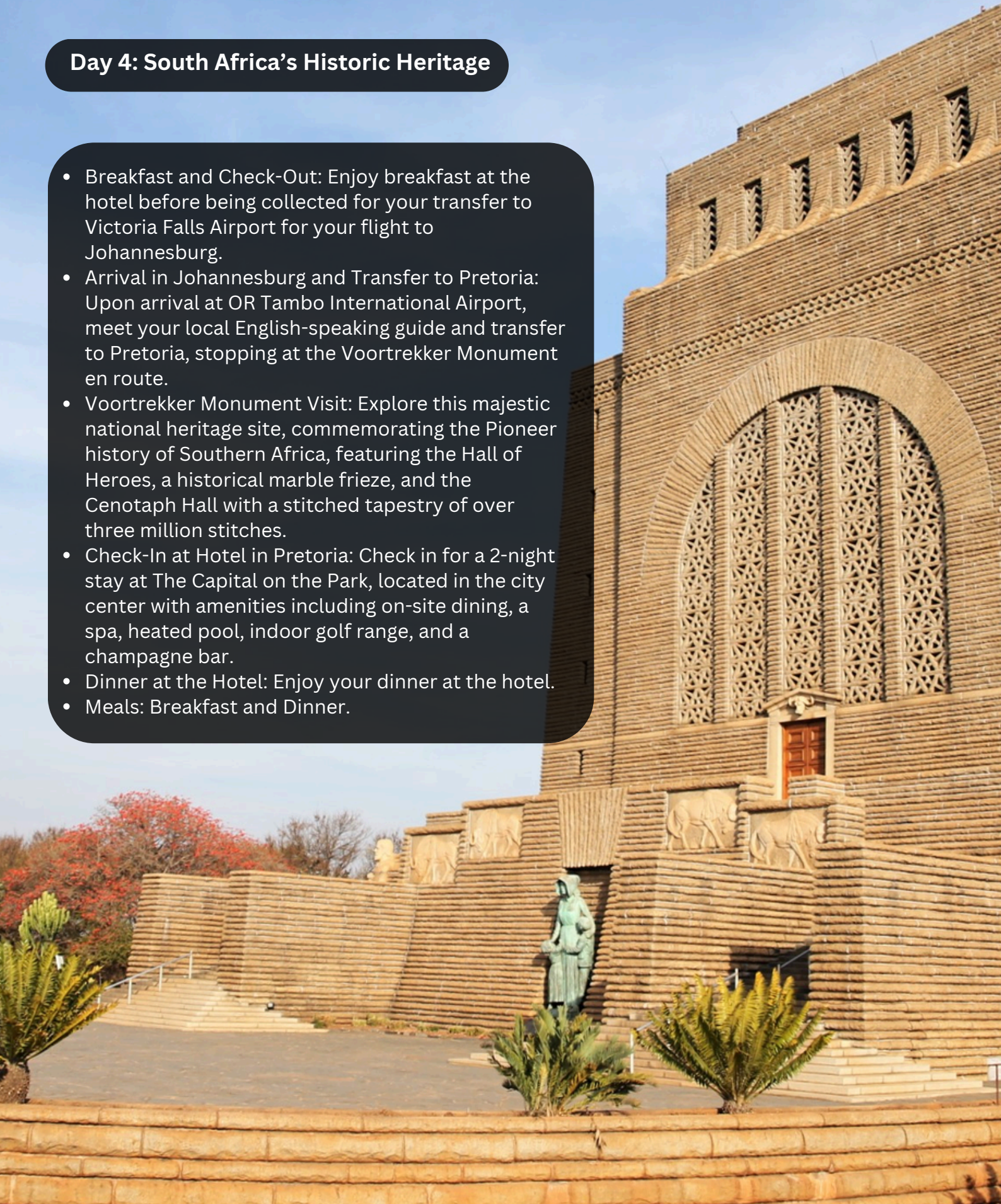
Day 3: Cruise the Chobe and Spot Wildlife

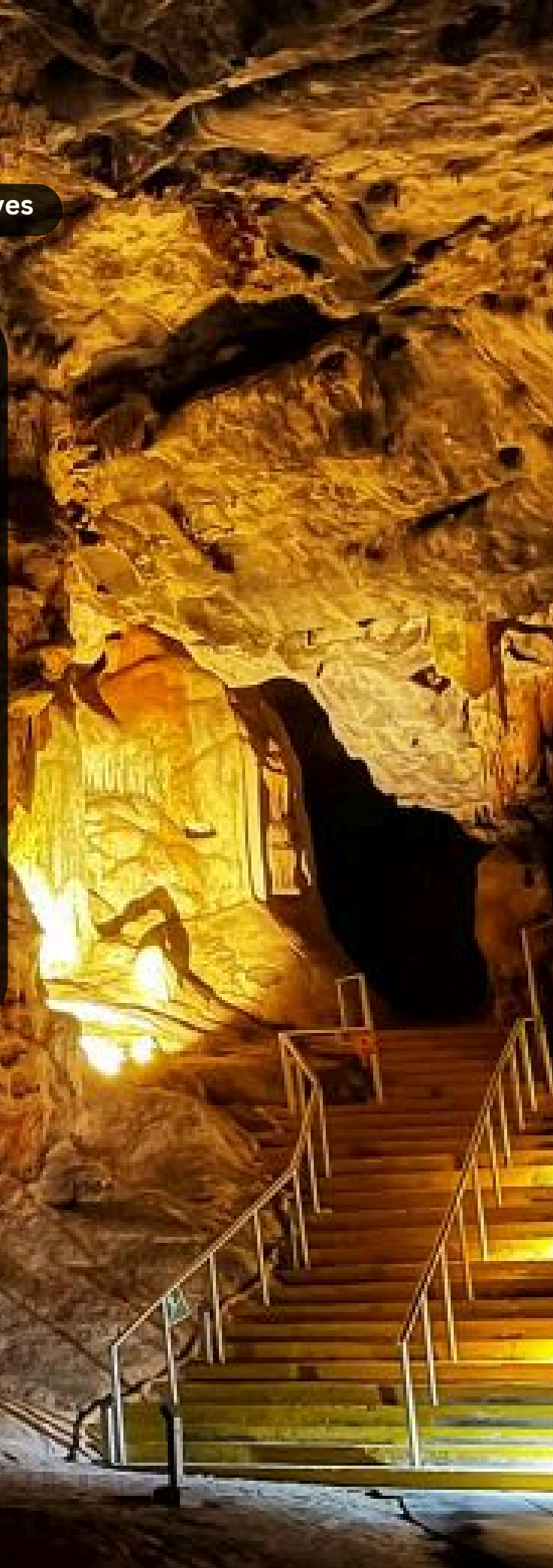
